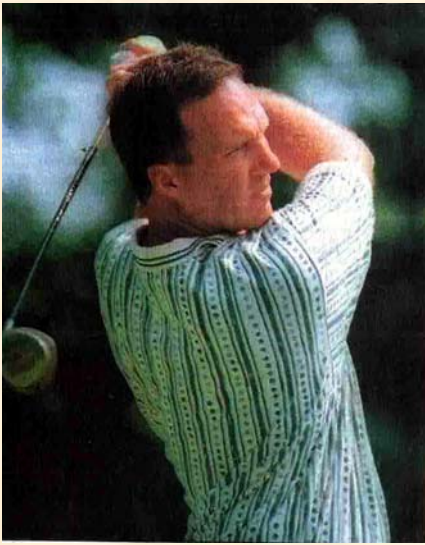


Legacy Funds



David McCampbell

David McCampbell was a 1977 graduate of Turkey Run High School and played college golf at Indiana State University. Following numerous amateur victories, David turned professional, playing on several PGA and Asian tours. David had more than 60 tournament victories as a professional, won several tour championships, was the Indiana Open Champion in 1999, and was once *Golf Week Magazine's* "Player of the Week."

Players on tour referred to him as the "Gentleman Farmer" reflecting his approach to people and his love for the family farm back in Parke County.

In 2001, David was diagnosed with cancer, and underwent surgery in New York City on September 11, the same morning as the terrorist attacks. After surgery, David continued playing professionally while fighting this deadly disease. David lost his battle with cancer in May, 2004.

His parents, Bob and Helen McCampbell, along with his sister, Nancy, and brother, Dan, created the David McCampbell Legacy Fund at the Parke County Community Foundation. They did this to memorialize his life and to recognize his contribution to athletics across the United States and abroad.

"Two Foundation fields of interest are Youth & Recreation and Agricultural Interests," shares Brad C. Bumgardner, Foundation Executive Director. "David would be pleased that the earnings from his fund are being used to include two of the community interests that meant so much to him."

Donors have established more than 100 Legacy Funds within the Foundation since 2001, the earnings from which fund grants to Parke County charities each year forever. A \$500 gift will begin a legacy fund, which can be added to in any amount at any time. All legacy gifts are tax-

deductible and can be funded with cash, securities, or real estate. Will you consider joining with hundreds of other donors making a difference in Parke County's future by establishing a legacy fund? The three current Legacy options are listed as follows:

1. *Legacy **Hallmark** Fund*—an unrestricted gift of \$500 or more.
2. *Legacy **Heritage** Fund*—when Legacy gifts reach \$10,000 or more.
3. *Legacy **Heirloom** Fund*—when Legacy gifts reach \$100,000 or more.

*Although no additional gifts are required to keep any fund active, donors are encouraged to consider future gifts (perhaps annually) so that the Legacy's impact will continue to grow in Parke County.
